The Early Years Safety Threads Program strongly aligns with the National Quality Framework and the Early Years Learning Framework and is designed to build educator confidence in teaching content that is often thought to be difficult.

 Warning Signs

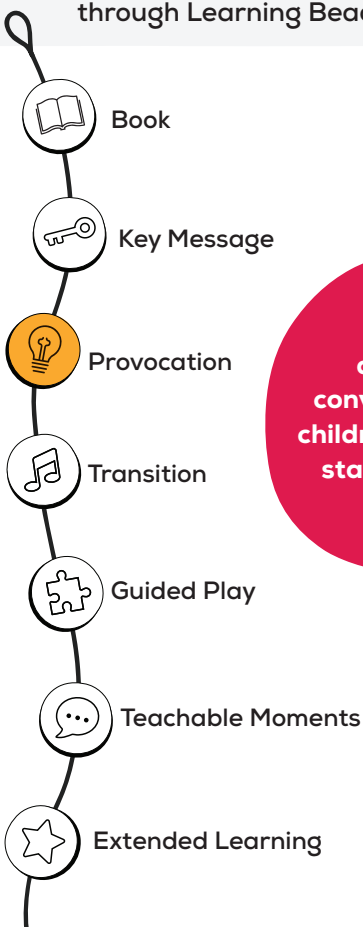
 Body Autonomy & Consent

Each Safety Thread scaffolds educator, child and parent learning through Learning Beads:



Having age appropriate conversations with children about safety starts in the early years.

The professional development journey for educators includes:
